# Couple with no children

Two adults in a couple relationship living in the same household

✓ the couple are FAP

# Couple with dependent children

Two adults + dependent children (U17yrs or U24yrs if full-time students) in the same household

the couple and any dependent children are FAP

# Couple with nondependent children

Two adults + nondependent children (18yrs+ or 25yrs+ if fulltime students) in the same household

This will be treated as at least two separate household types

#### Couple

The adult couple will be treated as one household

the couple are FAP

#### Non-dependent child

Each non-dependent child is treated as a single person household

X No FAP

## One Parent Households



# One parent with dependent children

One parent + dependent children (U17yrs or U24yrs if full-time students) in the same household

the parent and any dependent children are FAP

## One parent with nondependent children

One parent + nondependent children (18yrs+ or 25yrs+ if full-time students) in the same household

This will be treated as at least **two separate** households

#### Parent

The parent will be treated as a single person household

X No FAP

### Non-dependent child

Each non-dependent child will be treated as a single person household

X No FAP

## Other Households



## Single person

A single person household is where a person without a partner or dependent children is living either alone or with other people

X No FAP

## Group household

A household of two or more persons 15yrs+ where there are no couple, parent-child or other blood relationships present.

Each person will be treated as a single person household

X No FAP

# Geographically separated

A couple or
parent-child household that
is geographically separated
due to custody, long-term
residential care or student
accommodation

the couple and/or dependent children are FAP

## **Related Adults**

A household of two or more close adult relatives such as siblings

✓ FAP where joint tenants in property

No FAP in all othercircumstances
