REFERRAL PROTOCOL

FOR LEGAL ADVICE AND MINOR ASSISTANCE

Under this protocol,
Coalition Partners
agree to undertake
the following to
ensure our clients
receive the assistance
they need.

- There is a mutual obligation on all Coalition

 Partners to accept referrals where appropriate

 and practical.
- When a client approaches a Coalition Partner for assistance they will be asked if they have already seen another service or Coalition Partner.
- A Coalition Partner will not finalise a referral until the other Coalition Partner has accepted that referral.
- Where appropriate, the referring Coalition
 Partner will make an appointent with the other
 Coalition Partner on behalf of the client, and
 provide the client with a written confirmation.
- Referrals conducted as a part of minor assistance will be legal officer to legal officer and accompanied by formal handover of the matter including relevant documentation.
- Monitoring of referrals and interagency cooperation will occur as part of Cooperative Legal Service Delivery (CLSD) meetings.
- The referral process will not be used as a means of "disposing" of clients.
