


Population count by postcode




First Nations population count by postcode




Bathurst LGA, July 2020- June 2023




Forbes LGA, July 2020- June 2023




Orange LGA, July 2020- June 2023



Lithgow LGA, July 2020- June 2023




Total Fines Issued – Postcode 2795 (Bathurst)

Total Fines Issued – Postcode 2800 (Orange)





Total Fines Issued - Postcode 2790 (Lithgow)





Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2795 (Bathurst)





Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2871 (Forbes)





Total Overdue Fines, Postcode 2800 (Orange)





Total Overdue Fines, Postcode 2790 (Lithgow)





Total Overdue Fines, age 18-24 years – Postcode 2795 (Bathurst)





Total Overdue Fines, age 18-24 years – Postcode 2871 (Forbes)




