- National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA), December 2022












## First Nations population count by postcode






Index of relative socioeconomic disadvantage (SEIFA) by postcode





# Total Fines Issued – Postcode 2481 (Byron)





# Total Fines Issued – Postcode 2474 (Kyogle)





# Total Fines Issued - Postcode 2472 (Richmond Valley)







#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2478 (Ballina)





#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2481 (Byron)





#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2474 (Kyogle)





#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2480 (Lismore)





#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2472 (Richmond Valley)





#### Total Overdue Fines – Postcode 2485 (Tweed Heads)





### Total Overdue Fines, age 18-24 years – Postcode 2478 (Ballina)





### Total Overdue Fines, age 18-24 years – Postcode 2474 (Kyogle)





### Total Overdue Fines, age 18-24 years – Postcode 2480 (Lismore)




